Donated Goods Project

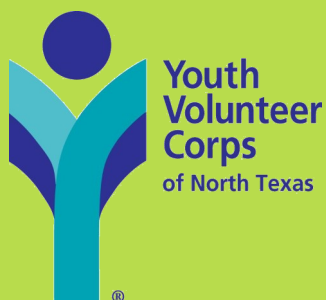
Serve in a local donated goods store to help process new and gently used items that will benefit hundreds of nonprofits in the Dallas area
